Notice of VTR 68-A and VIN Verification Inspection Schedule:

The Victoria Police Department's Auto Crimes Task Force conducts VTR 68-A and VIN verification inspections on certain vehicles at the request of the following Tax Assessor's Offices:

- Calhoun County
- Dewitt County
- Goliad County
- Gonzales County
- Lavaca County
- Refugio County
- Victoria County

When a person registers certain vehicle(s) in the State of Texas, their local tax office may require either a VTR 68-A or VIN Verification inspection. The citizen will be made aware of the need by their local tax assessor.

Due to the spike in COVID-19 cases, these inspection were temporarily suspended. This notice is to make any person(s) aware of the up and coming inspection dates, times, location(s) and documentation required.

IF you were made aware by one (1) of the above mentioned tax offices that your vehicle requires either a VTR 68-A or a VIN verification inspection, the Victoria Police Department's Auto Crimes Task Force will be conducting these types of inspections at the Victoria Community Center, 2905 E. North St., Victoria, TX., on the following specified dates:

These inspections begin promptly at 0930 hours and will continue until fifteen (15) minutes after the last inspection. If no person(s) arrive prior to 0945 hours, the inspection(s) will be cancelled for that specific date. At this time, there are no appointments required and the inspection is complimentary.

- Any and all documentation pertaining to the vehicle
- One way trip permit if not actively registered

MANUFACTURED TRAILER(S):

- Clean vehicle
- Proof of Ownership (bill of sale, registration, title and/or completed heirship documentation (FORM VTR 262))
- Any and all documentation pertaining to the vehicle
- One way trip permit if not actively registered

ASSEMBLED TRAILER(S) – HOMEMADE/SHOPBUILT:

- Clean vehicle
- Proof of Ownership (bill of sale, registration, title and/or completed heirship documentation)
- Any and all documentation pertaining to the vehicle
- Application for Texas Title (FORM 130-U) - Completed
- Trailer Verification Statement (FORM VTR-141) – Completed
- US Government issued ID or passport (driver's license if driving)
- Component Part(s) Bill of Sale (FORM VTR-63)
- Invoice/Receipts for material used
- One way trip permit if not actively registered
